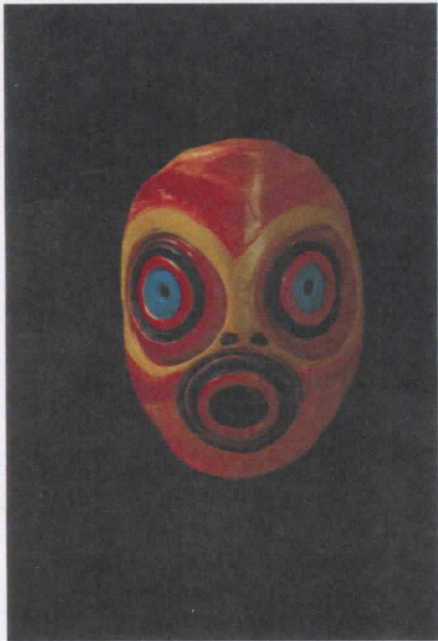

As an artist, I create drawings, hand-pulled prints, paintings, digital images, photographs, and assemblages. I actively participate in group and solo exhibitions. Upcoming exhibits include Global Print 8-2013 and the 8-2014 Douro Biennial, both in Portugal, and the Seventh Annual Louisiana Fine Art Showcase at Southeastern University, Hammond, LA. I am also an educator and exhibit organizer. I have taught at Tuskegee University in Alabama and Dillard University, Xavier University, and Delgado Community College in New Orleans, Louisiana.
